- An acceptable research proposal (applicants should visit www.hull.ac.uk/preparingresearchproposal, and work closely with relevant academic staff at the University of Hull)
- Two references
- Copy of Degree certificate(s) (if applicable)*
- Copy of transcript(s) *
- Copy of IELTS results* (In general, we require IELTS 6.0 (not lower than 5.5 in each skill, and IELTS 6.5 for Law, Politics, Business related programmes and English language related programmes; IELTS 7.5 or equivalent for Medical Science)
- Copy of passport

Once the candidate has submitted their online application they must also complete their online application to CSC. After this has been completed, we should be grateful if you could please pass the details of the nominate candidate to CSC.
